#### UNDECTECTABLE = UNTRANSMITTABLE

In 2016, Prevention Access Campaign mobilized activists, researchers, healthcare providers, and health officials to launch U=U with the following goals:

- ✓ Build a global science-based consensus on U=U.
- 2. Disseminate the widely unknown U=U science.
- 3. Advocate for access to quality treatment and care for people living with HIV to stay healthy and prevent new transmissions.





#### UNDETECTABLE = UNTRANSMITTABLE

# WHY IS U=U A GAME CHANGER?

- Improves quality of life of people living with HIV
- Reduces HIV stigma

  - Viral suppression: Increases adherence & viral suppression





## RISK OF SEXUAL TRANSMISSION OF HIV FROM A PERSON LIVING WITH HIV WHO HAS AN UNDETECTABLE VIRAL LOAD Messaging Primer & Consensus Statement.

Editor's Note: 1/10/18: The term "negligible" is not effective in public health messaging to describe the risk of HMV social transmission when a person with HMV has an undetectable viral load and is taking ART as prescribed. "Negligible" is often misconstrued as till a risk to take into consideration in social and reproductive health decisions. There is now evidence-based confirmation that the risk of HIV transmission from a person living with HIV (PLHIV), who is on Anthetroviral Therapy (ART) and has achieved an undetectable viral load in their blood for at least 6 months is negligible to non-existent. (Negligible is defined as: so small or unimportant as to be not worth considering; negligible to non-existent. (Negligible is defined as: so small or unimportant as to be not worth ornsidering; insignificant.) While HIV is not always transmitted even with a detectable viral load, when the partner with HIV has an undetectable viral load this both protects their own health and prevents new HIV infections.(i)

However, the majority of PLHIV, medical providers and those potentially at risk of acquiring HIV are not aware of the extent to which successful treatment prevents HIV transmission. (ii) Much of the messaging about HIV transmission risk is based on outdated research and is influenced by agency or funding restraints and politics which perpetuate sextensives HIV-related stigms and discrimination.

The consensus statement below, addressing HIV transmission risk from PLHIV who have an undetectable viral load, is endorsed by principal investigators from each of the leading studies that examined this issue. It is important that PLHIV, their interest partners and their healthcare providers have accurate information about risks of sexual transmission of HIV than those transmission of ART.





## POLICY BRIEF: The role of HIV viral suppression in improving individual health and reducing transmission July 2023 Health Equity: Access to viral load testing



Previously the WHO defined an undetectable viral load as ≤50 copies/mL, which limited options to plasma-based sample tests.

Undetectable is redefined as an undetectable result on any WHOprequalified test or sample type, including POC & dried blood spot samples, which can offer significantly greater <u>access</u> and <u>scalability</u>

This message from WHO should encourage the **scale-up of alternative sample types and platforms**, including dried blood spot assays and point-of-care tests, that may be less sensitive but will enable more PLHIV to receive vital information about their VL.

## POLICY BRIEF: The role of HIV viral suppression in improving individual health and reducing transmission July 2023 Health Equity: Clear communications



Undetectable viral load = ZERO risk of sexual transmission (<200 copies/mL = Zero risk)

Suppressed (but detected 200 to 1,000 copies/mL) = "Almost ZERO" or "Negligible" risk of sexual transmission

These powerful, positive messages from WHO should dispel any doubt about whether undetectable really does equal untransmittable. The benefits of treatment as prevention are clearer than ever before, which should encourage PLHIV to seek and adhere to treatment and support efforts to destigmatise and decriminalise HIV. The path to ending the AIDS epidemic has never seemed clearer.

#### Women deserve to make informed choices

## The WHO "recommends breastfeeding for women taking antiretroviral therapy"

Available evidence suggests that if a mother living with HIV is taking antiretroviral therapy and maintains a suppressed viral load during **pregnancy**, **delivery and breastfeeding**, the risk of vertical HIV transmission can be as low as <1%


If a mother is taking antiretroviral therapy and is undetectable **prior to and throughout pregnancy and delivery**, there is **no risk** of transmitting to the infant during **pregnancy**.

WHO guidance indicates that a pregnant mother living with HIV whose viral load is suppressed within four weeks of delivery is at low risk of transmitting HIV to their infant and recommends breastfeeding for women taking antiretroviral therapy.




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### Articulating U=U as a Win-Win-(win)



U=U perpetuates a 'virtuous cycle' of reinforcing impact. These include both the individual and public health benefits associated with reduced viral load and prevention of onward transmission, as well as broad-based (and in some cases still to be quantified) economic and societal benefits.

#### Individual and Public Health

- Reduced mortality and improved health outcomes for people with HIV;
- Decreased HIV transmission;
- Improved mental and sexual health of people with HIV;
- Improved HIV testing rates, treatment uptake and adherence:
- Investment in service delivery with broad-based health implications;



#### HIV Viral Load and Transmissibility of HIV Infection

Undetectable Equals Untransmittable

In 2016, the Prevention Access Campaign, a health equity initiative with the goal of ending the HIV/AIDS pandemic as well as HIV-related stigma, launched the Undetectable = Untransmittable (U = U) initiative.  $^{1}$  U = U signifies that individuals with HIV who receive antiretroviral therapy (ART) and have achieved and maintained an undetectable viral load cannot sexually transmit the virus to others. This concept, based on strong scientific evidence, has broad implications for treatment of HIV infection from a scientific and public health standpoint, for the self-esteem of individuals by reducing the stigma associated with HIV,2 and for certain legal aspects of HIV criminalization. 3 In this Viewpoint, we examine the underlying science-based evidence supporting this important concept and the behavioral, social, and legal implications associated with the acceptance of the U = U concept.

Subsequent studies confirmed and extended these findings. The PARTNER 1 study determined the risk of HIV transmission via condomless sexual intercourse in 1166 HIV-discordant couples in which the partner with HIV was receiving ART and had achieved and maintained viral suppression (HIV-1RNA viral load < 200 copies/mL). After approximately 58 000 condomless sexual acts, there were no linked HIV transmissions.3 Since a minority of the HIV-discordant couples in PARTNER1 were men who have sex with men (MSM), there was insufficient statistical power to determine the effect of an undetectable viral load on the transmission risk for receptive anal sex. In this regard, the Opposites Attract study evaluated transmissions involving 343 HIV-discordant MSM couples in Australia, Brazil, and Thailand, After 16 800 acts of condomless anal intercourse there were no linked HIV transmissions during 588.4 couple-vears

manifestations of HIV disease. Not only did ART provide a nearly normal life expectancy for most people with HIV who adhered to their treatment regimens, it also eliminated the risk of transmitting the virus to an uninfected sexual partner. It became clear that treating people with HIV was a highly effective means of preventing HIV spread. "Treatment as prevention" proved to be a critical addition to the prevention tool kit that also contained measures such as condom use, voluntary medical male circumcision, and screening of the blood supply. Studies of these interventions also provided the critical evidence base for the principle that "undetectable equals untransmittable," or "U=U," which has helped reduce some of the external and sometimes self-imposed stigma associated with HIV infection.
